Mainz the state capital of Rhineland-Palatinate combines an ancient culture with joie de vivre. It is the home of the German Wine Institute and is the wine capital of Germany; outside the city is the largest German wine-growing area, Rheinhessen, with a number of award-winning vintners.

Mainz has been many things to many people: The Roman Castrum Moguntiacum – capital of the Electorate of Mainz at the time of the Holy Roman Empire, the Jewish Magenza, the residence and capital of the Prince Electors, an archbishopric, a university town and a fortress town of the German Nation's Holy Roman Empire as well as the Mainz Republic. These are all epochs of "Golden Mainz" as the city has been known since its heyday in the Middle Ages. The city is also famous for the invention of the movable-type printing press and the first books printed by Johannes Gutenberg, Marc Chagall's sparkling blue stained glass windows in St. Stephan's Church and the Carnival which marks out the fifth season the highlight of which is a kilometre-long procession through the streets of the city.
