Lucas Cranach the Elder ranks among the most eminent painters of the German Renaissance. He was a close friend of Martin Luther and had a significant influence on artists across the centuries. The exhibition "CRANACH. Master – Brand – Modernity" explores Cranach the Elder's productivity and activity, demonstrating his successful strategies and the influence of this exceptional artist on modern and contemporary art. The exhibition brings together more than 200 works of art from international museums like the Metropolitan Museum of Art in New York or the National Gallery in London to contrast Cranach's work with other Renaissance artists like Dürer, Holbein or de' Barbari as well to show his influence on artists like Picasso, Giacometti and Warhol.
